

AGREED TERMS

The definitions and rules of interpretation for the following Terms & Conditions ("Terms and Conditions") are as follows:

- "Tournament" or "Main Tournament" refers to the main event of the Volvo Padel Open 2026 to be held from the 23 of October to the 25 of October 2026.
- "Beginner Qualifier" or "Qualifiers" refers to the mandatory pre-selection assessment phase hosted by the respective Padel Communities, taking place between 13 September and 11 October, 2026, to determine the final participating Beginner teams.
- "Community Edition" or "Community Tournament" refers to the main community-based division of the Tournament, comprising the Beginner, Lower Intermediate, and Upper Intermediate categories across Men's and Women's tiers, played as structured teams representing their respective Padel Communities between the 23 and 25 of October 2026.
- "Premier Edition" refers to the open category of the Tournament, accessible to all individuals including full-time coaches, national players, and professionals – provided they are Malaysian citizens or hold a valid student visa, work permit, or Long-Term Social Visit Pass ("Spouse Visa"). It features Men's and Mix Doubles (8 teams) in a direct knockout format. The registration fee is MYR 400 per team.
- "Organiser" or "the Organiser" refers to Volvo Car Malaysia Sdn Bhd with Registration No. 199901007530 [482430-K] with its business address at Lot 01-13A, 13A Floor, Menara Symphony, 5, Jalan Professor Khoo Kay Kim, Seksyen 13, 46200 Petaling Jaya, Selangor, Malaysia.
- "Event Partner(s)" refers to JOY DIVISION PADEL SDN BHD with Registration No. 202401022348 [1568197-W] located at Lot 20D, Jalan Penchala, Petaling Jaya, 46050 Selangor, Malaysia ("Joy Division Padel") who are the participating padel court operators for the Tournament.
- "Padel Community" or "Padel Communities" refers to any invited padel club, association, or group that has officially registered and paid the required deposit, strictly limited to a total pool of either exactly eight (8) or sixteen (16) participating communities.
- "Community Head" refers to the designated leader, representative, or person-in-charge of the respective Padel Community who acts as the primary liaison with the Organiser.
- "Food and Beverage Partner(s)" refers to "Kitchen by Others" or any food and beverage partner(s) appointed by Joy Division Padel.
- "Agent of Organiser" refers to persons, contractors, service providers, match referees, linesmen, volunteers and agencies appointed by the Organiser and/or the Event Partner(s) to facilitate the organisation of the Tournament.
- "Participant(s)" refers to individuals taking part in the Tournament and Beginner Qualifier that have completed the registration process.

GENERAL

1. The Organiser reserves the right to unilaterally add to, modify, or substitute any of these Terms and Conditions, as well as modify the program, venue, or schedule as necessary, at any time without prior notice. In the event of any ambiguity in the provisions herein, the Organiser shall have the sole authority and discretion to interpret the provision(s) as it deems fit.
2. If a Participant cannot accept these Terms and Conditions or the risks associated with the event, they must not proceed with registration. By participating, the Participant confirms that they have read and understood the rules and regulations of the event as released from time to time and agree to strictly adhere to them.
3. By participating in the Tournament, Beginner Qualifier, and/or the Premier Edition the Participant acknowledges their agreement to all provisions within these Terms and Conditions. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse, disqualify, or restrict any Participant from taking part in the event, accessing its entitlements, or claiming any prizes.

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TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION

- Registration for the **Tournament** must be conducted via the official registration microsite:
 - 1.1. Beginner Category: Qualification and entry strictly through the Beginner Qualifier managed by the respective Padel Community, subject entirely to the absolute discretion and validation of the Community Head.
 - 1.2. Lower Intermediate and Upper Intermediate: The Padel Community to decide and select participants, subject entirely to the absolute discretion and validation of the Community Head.
 - 1.3. Premier Edition: Registration for the Premier Edition is conducted via the official website at <https://padel.volvocarmalaysia.com/>. No registration will be accepted via email, mobile communications, or direct communications with the Organiser, Event Partner(s), and/or Agent(s).
- The following persons are not allowed to participate in the Event:
 - 2.1. Executive directors and employees of the Organiser and Event Partners;
 - 2.2. Contractors, affiliates, appointed Agents or agencies, business partners, suppliers, representatives of the Organiser and/or the Event Partners, and their respective immediate family members (spouse, children, parents, and siblings);
 - 2.3. Certified padel coaches and professional players are strictly prohibited from participating in any category within the Community Edition, and are only permitted to register for the Premier Edition;
 - 2.4. Non-citizens or non-residents of Malaysia without a valid student visa, work permit or Long-Term Social Visit Pass ("Spouse Visa");
 - 2.5. Registrants below the age of eighteen (18) years; and/or,
 - 2.6. Persons with a health or medical condition that can pose a risk to their health or wellbeing of others by participating in the Tournament.

4. The Organiser reserves the right to close registration early and/or move new registrations into a waitlist if Tournament slots are filled.
5. Padel Communities and Participants must adhere to the structured payment schedule:
 - 5.1. A mandatory deposit (MYR 2,600) is due upon initial community registration between 5 September 2026 till 6 September 2026 at 9pm. Priority is given strictly to the first eight (8) registered communities based on payment timestamps.
 - 5.2. If final registrations land between 9 and 15 Padel Communities and do not reach 16 Padel Communities, the Tournament will proceed with 8 Padel Communities, and slots 9 through 15 will receive a full refund.
 - 5.3. Balance payments are due by 11 October 2026, amounting to
 - 5.3.1. A total of MYR 8,000 for an 8 Padel Community structure (20 teams / 40 players per community) or;
 - 5.3.2. A total of MYR 4,000 for a 16 Padel Community structure (10 teams / 20 players per community)
 - 5.3.3. Registrants on the waitlist are not considered Participants until they have been directly contacted by the Organiser and/or its Agents with confirmation of the registration process.
6. The following details will be collected as part of the registration process: Full name, email address, mobile phone number, national identification number and digital copy thereof, gender, t-shirt size of the Participant (and their teammate/partner if applicable).
7. Volvo car owners are additionally required to submit their Vehicle Identification Number ("VIN") and car model to enjoy additional participation benefits.
8. It is the Community Head's sole responsibility to register Participants in the correct category based on a truthful self-assessment of their playing ability, or risk forfeiture with no refund.
9. Participants can only register for one (1) Padel Community to represent.
10. The Participant warrants and agrees that all information provided by the registrant during the registration process for this Tournament shall be true, accurate, current, and complete. If at any point in time, the Organiser has grounds to believe that such information provided by the Participant is untrue, inaccurate, obsolete, or incomplete, the Organiser may disqualify, suspend, or cancel the Participant's registration without any disputes nor refunds of the registration fee.
11. The Organiser shall not entertain nor be in any way responsible for any disputes, discrepancies, or complaints arising from incomplete or inaccurate entry details by the Participant during the registration process. Any Participant found to have registered with incorrect, false, or inaccurate details shall be strictly subject to immediate disqualification from the Tournament without appeal or refund.
12. Registration for the Tournament shall only be deemed confirmed upon receipt of full payment and the issuance of a confirmation email by the Organiser and/or its Agents to the respective:
 - 12.1. Community Head (for all Community Edition categories, upon remittance of the required community deposit and balance payments).
 - 12.2. Participant (for the Premier Edition, upon direct remittance of the MYR 400 team registration fee).
13. Payments are processed by an authorised Agent of the Organiser through a secure, third-party payment gateway or via coordinated community deposits. All transactions are in Ringgit Malaysia. The Organiser and/or its Agent(s) shall not be liable for any financial loss by Participants resulting from payment processing or foreign bank exchange differences.
14. No-Refund Policy: No refunds will be given for whatsoever reason once registrations have been successfully processed by the Organiser (with the sole exception of the 9-to-15 community threshold refund policy outlined in Clause 5.2). This includes but is not limited to Participant withdrawals,

walkovers, disqualifications, and forfeitures before or during the Tournament, personal circumstances, or reasons preventing the Participant from participating or claiming Tournament entitlements.

BEGINNER QUALIFIER

1. Registration for the Community Beginner Qualifier is conducted via the official website at <https://padel.volvocarmalaysia.com/>. No registration will be accepted via email, mobile communications, or direct communications with the Organiser, Event Partner(s), and/or Agent(s).
2. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse, disqualify, or restrict any Participant from participating in the Tournament and/or accessing the entitlements of the Tournament and claims thereto.
3. Community Head must indicate the intended date of their qualifier session and the estimated number of players during the initial registration which opens on 5 September 2026 and ends on Sunday, 6 September 2026 at 9.00pm.
4. The submission window for Beginner Qualifier players is open from the 8 September 2026 to 4 October 2026.
5. The Qualifier matches must be played between the 13 September 2026 and 11 October 2026. If a Padel Community's registration is filled before the 13 September, they may commence qualifiers as early from the 11 September 2026.
6. Padel Community is solely liable for the Beginner Qualifier.
7. Qualifier matches may only be held at Joy Division Padel, Joy Division Padel 2, or Pop Padel.
8. Each Beginner Qualifier must host a minimum of sixteen (16) players and a maximum of sixty-four (64) players. Participants may compete in a maximum of two (2) Beginner Qualifiers.
9. Participants are strictly permitted to register for and represent only one (1) Padel Community throughout the Tournament. Even if a Participant competes in and wins multiple (2) Beginner Qualifiers, they must exclusively declare and represent a single Padel Community. Any attempt to register for or represent multiple Padel Communities is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate disqualification from the Tournament.
10. The Padel Community reserves the absolute right to close registration early or place new registrations on a waitlist immediately upon all allocated slots for the Beginner Qualifier being filled.
11. Registration for the Beginner Qualifier shall officially close either three (3) days prior to the submitted qualifier date, or as soon as all allocated slots are filled, whichever occurs first.
12. Registrations for the Beginner Qualifier shall only be deemed complete and confirmed upon the immediate and successful payment of the MYR 50 Qualifier Fee at the time of registration. Any registration submitted without immediate full payment will be automatically voided, and the slot will be released to other registrants in the queue.
13. The following details will be collected as part of the registration process: Full name, email address, mobile phone number, national identification number and digital copy thereof, gender, t-shirt size of the Participant.
14. Payments are processed by an authorised Agent of the Organiser through a secure, third-party payment gateway. All transactions are in Ringgit Malaysia. The Organiser and/or its Agent(s) shall not be liable for any financial loss by Participants resulting from the misuse of said payment gateway. The MYR 50 collected from all registered Participants will be funnelled back to the respective Community Heads to run their respective Beginner Qualifiers.
15. The execution of each individual Beginner Qualifier is at the discretion of the respective Padel Community, provided it adheres to the rules herein. The Padel Community is solely liable for the execution and management of its Beginner Qualifier.

16. The final Beginner Category Participant name list (Men's and Women's) must be submitted by 11 October 2026. The absolute winners of the Beginner Qualifier must be chosen to represent their Padel Community in the Community Edition Beginner category.

TOURNAMENT CATEGORIES & STRUCTURE GAMEPLAY

1. All matches in the Tournament are played in doubles format only according to the prevailing rules and regulations of padel as determined by the Organiser, covering the Community Edition (Beginner, Lower Intermediate, Upper Intermediate) and the Premier Edition across the official dates of 23 to 25 October 2026 at Joy Division Padel and Joy Division Padel 2.
2. The following categories are:

The organizer reserves the right to modify the program, venue, or schedule as necessary.

3. The Tournament categories and structures are as follows:
 - 3.1. Beginner Category: Features a total pool of up to one hundred and twenty-eight (128) players across Men's and Women's sub-categories, with each Padel Community operating as a fixed squad comprising a total of eight (8) or sixteen (16) Participants, depending on the final confirmed number of Padel Communities
 - 3.2. Lower & Upper Intermediate Men Categories: Features a total pool of up to one hundred and twenty eight (128) players across Lower and Upper Intermediate Men Categories, with each Padel Community operating as a fixed squad comprising a total of eight (8) or sixteen (16) Participants, depending on the final confirmed number of Padel Communities
 - 3.3. Lower & Upper Intermediate Women Categories: Features a total pool of up to sixty-four (64) players across Lower and Upper Intermediate Women Categories, with each Padel Community operating as a fixed squad comprising a total of four (4) or eight (8) Participants, depending on the final confirmed number of Padel Communities
 - 3.4. The Premier Edition is open to all individuals – including full-time coaches, national players, and touring professionals – provided they are Malaysian citizens or hold a valid student visa, work permit, or Long-Term Social Visit Pass (“Spouse Visa”). It features Men's and Mix Doubles (8 teams) in a direct knockout format. The registration fee is MYR 400 per team.

4. Participant groupings and brackets will be drawn randomly after all registrations and Beginner Qualifiers are completed. Participants will be able to view their groupings and the official Tournament leaderboard on the official website.
5. Each Padel Community category operates as a fixed squad comprising a total of:
 - 5.1. Beginner Men Category: Four (4) or Eight (8) Participants
 - 5.2. Beginner Women Category: Four (4) or Eight (8) Participants
 - 5.3. Lower & Upper Intermediate Men categories: Four (4) or Ten (Eight) Participants
 - 5.4. Lower & Upper Intermediate Women categories: Two (2) or Four (4) Participants
6. No external substitutions are permitted for Participants and Padel Communities in any of Community Categories

TOURNAMENT GAMEPLAY

1. Community Heads are required to be at venue and present themselves to the Organiser, Event Partners, and/or the Agents for a pre-tournament briefing at 7:30am of each Tournament day
2. Participants are required to be at the venue and present themselves to the Organiser, Event Partners, and/or the Agents at least thirty (30) minutes before the estimated start of each match.
3. The official Tournament t-shirt (distributed during the Sports Kit distribution on 19th October 2026) must be worn at every match. Any Participant failing to wear the official Tournament t-shirt during a match shall be subject to immediate disqualification from the match and/or Tournament.
4. The Participant warrants and agrees that all information provided during the registration process for the Tournament shall be true, accurate, current, and complete. If at any point in time the Organiser determines that the information provided by a Participant is untrue, inaccurate, false, or incomplete, the individual Participant shall be immediately disqualified from the Tournament without refund. Consequently, the offending Participant's team shall automatically forfeit, and if any matches have already been played, all prior match results involving the offending Participant will be overturned and officially recorded as a 6-0 loss against their team.
5. Match Formats by Category:
 - 5.1. Beginner Category:
 - 5.1.1. Group stages and qualifiers are played as round-robin sets leading into quarter-finals, semi finals (full set), and grand finals as outlined in the official bracket schedules.
 - 5.1.2. Before each match, teams choose to start the serve or their side of the court by winning a coin toss.
 - 5.1.3. If in a game, both teams are tied at game point at 40-40 ("40-all" or "deuce"), the match will end with one (1) decisive winning point from either team ("golden point").
 - 5.2. Intermediate Categories (Lower & Upper - Men's & Women's)
 - 5.2.1. Group qualifying matches are played in standard padel scoring in a round-robin format (1 set per round robin match).
 - 5.2.2. Quarter-finals and semi-finals consist of elimination rounds played in full sets, leading up to the grand finals.
 - 5.2.3. If in a game, both teams are tied at game point at 40-40 ("40-all" or "deuce"), the match will end with one (1) decisive winning point from either team ("golden point").
 - 5.3. Premier Edition:
 - 5.3.1. Features Men's and Mixed Doubles (8 teams) in a direct knockout format consisting of quarter-finals, semi-finals (full set), and finals.
 - 5.3.2. Standard international scoring rules apply with golden points on deuces.
6. The Organiser, Event Partners, and/or Agents shall provide umpires/linesmen and scorekeepers throughout matches, but it is also the responsibility of Participants to keep score and call out faults in fairness and the spirit of good sportsmanship.
7. In scoring or gameplay disputes, the umpire's final decision is incontestable. Prolonged escalation of disputes by Participants, hostile or otherwise, will result in immediate forfeiture of the match.
8. The Organiser reserves the right to amend gameplay, program, venue, and/or Tournament format unconditionally and without prior notice.

PRIZES

1. The Organiser is offering total cash prizes exceeding MYR 115,000 to the winners of the Tournament.
2. Prizes for the respective Padel Community and/or Participants of each category are broken down as follows:

3. All cash prizes and entitlements are non-transferable, non-exchangeable for cash (other than the designated cash prize structure), and subject to compliance with all Tournament rules and regulations herein.
4. All winners are required to produce a valid identification document and sign an acknowledgment document, which must be collected by the respective Community Head upon the collection of prizes and/or vouchers.
5. The value of cash prizes is allocated per Padel Community across all categories.
6. Cash prizes will be paid to the Community Head of each winning Padel Community and Participants of the Premier Edition within 7 working days after the end of the Tournament. Winners will be contacted by the appointed Agent of the Organiser (LAB Activation Sdn Bhd with Registration No. 201401011867 [1087944-H]) to arrange for payment to a bank account of the winners' choice. Transactions will be in Ringgit Malaysia, and the Organiser and/or its Agents shall not be liable for any additional transaction fees and/or foreign exchange rates imposed by the winners' chosen bank.
7. The Organiser reserves the right to vary the prizes without prior notice with items of equivalent value if the listed prizes are unavailable.
8. The Organiser shall not entertain any dispute or appeal regarding the results after the prize presentation ceremony of the Tournament.

ATTIRE & ETIQUETTE

1. The official Volvo Padel Open t-shirt included in the Participants' sports kit must be worn during every match.
2. Only two (2) t-shirts will be given per Participant. It is the Participants' responsibility to maintain the t-shirt between matches and match dates. Any request to change t-shirt sizes after the registration process will not be entertained.
3. Participants should wear comfortable sports bottoms during matches (e.g., tennis shorts, track pants or tennis skirts), and comfortable, durable sports shoes during matches. Open-toe footwear, slippers, flip-flops, sandals, and bare feet are not allowed.
4. Participants shall be solely responsible for the safekeeping of their personal belongings, and the Organiser, Event Partners and/or Agents shall in no way be held responsible for any loss of or damage to personal property as a result of participation in the Event.
5. Participants shall always uphold good sportsmanship both on-court and off-court. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify and refuse entry to Participants who engage in the use of abusive, offensive, harassing, threatening or inappropriate language in any way, shape and form directed to the Organiser, Event Partner(s), their Agents, and/or other Participants via personal interaction, email, mobile phone communications, and social media platforms, both before and during the Tournament.
6. Only Participants are allowed access to Tournament courts. The Organiser, Event Partner(s) and/or its Agents reserve the right to ask non-participating guests to evacuate Participant-priority areas such as courtside benches and refreshment areas.

SPORTS KIT COLLECTION

1. The official Volvo Padel Open sports kits can be collected on 19 October 2026 at the Event Partners' venue, Joy Division Padel 2 (JOY2)
2. Community Head must collect the sports kit in person and present a valid identification document during collection. Community Head is responsible for distributing the sports kits to their respective players.
3. The sports kit will contain 2 pieces official Volvo Padel Open t-shirt that must be worn during all matches.

FORFEITURES AND DISQUALIFICATIONS

1. Participants and teams forfeit their match and/or progress at any point during the Tournament if:
 - 1.1. The registered information provided by a Participant is untrue, inaccurate, false, or incomplete;
 - 1.2. One or both Participants in the same team are not present at the court five (5) minutes before the start of a scheduled match;
 - 1.3. One or both Participants in the same team decide not to continue their participation in the current match, the next match and/or the remainder of the Tournament ("walkover");
 - 1.4. One or both Participants in the same team is pregnant, has a medical condition, injury or disability that prevents them from participating safely, in which case participants must inform the umpire/Organiser/Event Partner/Agent(s) immediately if they are feeling unfit to play;
 - 1.5. The umpire/Organiser/Event Partner/Agent(s) have reasonable grounds to believe that a Participant has a medical condition, injury or disability that prevents them from participating safely, and which may pose physical and mental risks to themselves and other Participants; and/or,
 - 1.6. Any other reasons caused by a Participant that prevents, delays, or challenges the progress and/or timely continuation of the Tournament.
2. Any forfeiture, walkover, or retirement by a Participant or team during a match automatically awards a match win to the opposing team, with the final recorded score determined as follows:

- 2.1. In the event a Participant or team must retire from a match mid-game due to injury, the opposing team will be awarded the win with a score of six (6) games. The retiring team shall retain the number of games they had successfully scored prior to retiring/walking over (e.g., recorded as a 6-[retained score] loss for the injured team).
 - 2.2. For any other reasons resulting in a forfeiture, walkover, or disqualification (including but not limited to absence, tardiness, or disciplinary action), the match win will be automatically awarded to the opposing team with a definitive score of 6-0 against the forfeiting team.
